Resolved Issues

This patch includes fixes for the following issues when applied over the RealPresence Collaboration Server (RMX) 8.8.1.6 release.

Issue ID	Category	Description
EN-198283	Stability	Calls from a specific type of third-party endpoint to the RMX fail as the firewall terminates the session after 5 seconds (or greater) of no response.

Known Issues

Following is the list of known issues present in this patch release.

Issue ID	Category	Description
EN-199253	Video	Three-screen video endpoints in a conference are counted as three participants rather than one participant.
EN-199662	Video	The Participant Count is not displayed on the last endpoint joining a conference if an ITP endpoint is already in the conference.

What's New in this Release

This RealPresence Collaboration Server 8.8.1.7 release has a new feature that allows it to receive the video and audio participant count of a Virtual Meeting Room (VMR) conference from the RealPresence DMA 10.0.0.9 system, rather than doing the internal computation of the participant count. This feature improves the accuracy of the displayed participant count in large cascaded conferences.

A new system flag called <code>ENABLE_PARTICIPANT_COUNT_FROM_DMA</code> enables this feature, which is enabled (set to YES) by default, but RealPresence DMA system version 10.0.0.9 is required along with RMX version 8.8.1.7.



IMPORTANT NOTES:

 The participant count is displayed on an endpoint only if it joins the conference as an AVC endpoint.

- If participants are moved or dropped from the RMX Manager, the RealPresence DMA system will
 no longer have an accurate participant count. We recommend that you do not use the RMX
 Manager to move or remove participants from a VMR conference.
- The cascade link itself is not counted as a participant.
- If there are more than 99 participants in a conference, the RMX displays "99+" as the participant count on endpoint video screen.
- This new feature does not update the participant counts displayed in Gathering mode. If
 Gathering mode is enabled for a VMR conference, the video and audio participant counts
 displayed by the RMX on the Gathering page indicate only the number of endpoints directly
 connected to the RMX, as per the existing functionality.
